Car crashes are the leading killer of American teens from ages 15 – 20, with more than 5,000 fatal crashes each year and an additional 196,000 injured.

- Students will receive a valuable classroom session and will learn, hands-on, how to manage every day driving hazards, obstacles and challenges in a controlled environment on an advanced driving course to ultimately "arrive alive."
- Students learn emergency braking and skid control, how to control proper braking, and **how to avoid accidents entirely**. Additionally, students and parents will get to sit in a parked 18-wheeler to fully comprehend its massive blind spots, teenagers witness the violent detonation of an airbag, which reinforces proper hand placement on the steering wheel.
- Students are taught in their own cars, not specially prepared program vehicles, so the skills they learn can be directly translated to their daily driving exercises. **Tire Rack Street Survival challenges teenagers to understand how to control a vehicle, rather than just operate one.**

Tire Rack Street Survival is open to licensed drivers ages **16 and up**. Forms, schedules and more information can be found online at www.streetsurvival.org. The cost is \$95 per student. Some insurance companies offer premium discounts to graduates.

The program is in its 17th year having trained over 25,000 new drivers in over 1,100 schools.
